- Increase national awareness and support for RDM’s international mission efforts

This transition allows RDM to focus its U.S. operations on training, media, partnerships, and strategic fundraising — while continuing to support vibrant chapters across Kenya through the newly formed Redemptive Dance Foundation NGO.

“We’re not shrinking — this is necessary for the vision of multiplication that God gave to come to fruition,” said Johnson. “By releasing the management of local chapters and raising up licensed leaders, we’re stewarding the vision with greater clarity and sustainability. It’s about empowering the next generation of worshippers and leaders to rise up.”
