A YEAR OF MINISTRY IMPACT

Throughout 2025, Redemptive Dance Ministries continued to grow in faithfulness and purpose by equipping leaders and discipling young people through Christ-centered programs and community partnerships.

BY THE NUMBERS

Throughout 2025, Redemptive Dance Ministries served students and communities across multiple regions and ministry contexts.

Programs & Classes:

Last year, RDM offered ongoing dance classes, workshops, and discipleship-focused programming designed to build confidence, community, and faith through movement and discipleship.

Locations & Regions:

RDM served students in both local and international settings, including the United States, Kenya, and Zimbabwe partnering with instructors and leaders to bring Christ-centered dance education into diverse communities.

Community Contexts:

Programs took place in studios, community spaces, and partner locations—meeting students where they are and creating welcoming environments for growth and discipleship.

WHO WE SERVED

This year marked an important season of transition for Redemptive Dance Ministries. God led us to strengthen our foundation by focusing on discipleship, leadership development, and sustainable growth.

We invested in training resources, curriculum development and systems that will allow local leaders to serve the youth more effectively in their own communities.

● Communities Reached


Through ongoing partnerships and consistent programming, RDM continued to serve returning communities while also expanding into new locations. RDM strengthened relationships and deepened long-term impact.

	Total Expenses	\$ 77 Thousand




We lived within our means.

A YEAR OF STRATEGIC TRANSITION

In early 2025, Redemptive Dance Ministries completed a significant strategic shift from primarily teaching students in local studios to equipping leaders who can multiply impact within their own communities.


Beginning in late spring, RDM intentionally reduced local class offerings and redirected time and resources toward building long-term ministry infrastructure. This included the development of a new website, mobile app, web portal, and educational courses designed to support leader training, which is currently centered in Africa.

While this shift resulted in a temporary reduction in tuition-based income, it positioned the ministry for sustainable, scalable, and globally rooted impact.
